The Neighbourhood Care Scheme is a good neighbour scheme that operates in the Hanover, Queens Park, Coombe Road, North Laine, North Portslade, Poets Corner/Vallance, Regency, and Hangleton & Knoll areas. The Scheme puts older people and people with physical disabilities who have trouble getting out of their homes in touch with local people who can carry out a variety of tasks for them on a voluntary basis. Volunteers and scheme users are interviewed and matched to each other after appropriate references have been taken. In the Hangleton & Knoll and Queens Park neighbourhoods our volunteers are also able to support carers.
